A few years later, in 1908, Curt Teich Co. introduced postcards to their portfolio, and over the next few decades became the world's largest printer of view and advertising postcards. Curt Teich was an early pioneer of the offset printing process, and the first to understand the advantages of using lightly embossed paper to speed up the drying of ink, allowing the finished product to retain brighter colors.

History of the postcard

The first government-produced postcard was issued on May 1, 1873. 1 One side

of the postcard was for a message and the other side was for the recipient's address. By law, the government postcards were the only postcards allowed to bear the term "Postal Card." Private publishers were still allowed to print postcards, but they were more expensive to mail than the government-produced cards (2¢ instead of 1¢) .

Postcard, a card for transmitting a message that can be mailed without an envelope. The first government-issued cards were the straw-colored Austrian Korrespondenz Karte (with a two-kreuzer stamp) issued in October 1869.
