The first attempt to reduce the Roman-Dutch civil law to a system was made by Hugo Grotius in his Introduction to the Jurisprudence of Holland, written while he was in prison in 1619–20 and published in 1631; this short treatise, a masterpiece of condensed exposition, remains a legal classic. Grotius's commentaries were followed by those of Johannes Voet and Simon van Groenewegen van der Made.
