The small intestine has three parts: the duodenum, where most of the chemical digestion occurs; and the jejunum and the ileum, where absorption of water and nutrients occurs. Additionally, the lining of the small intestine has finger-like projections called villi and microvilli that increase the surface area in order to increase absorption!

The glands of the digestive system consist of the tongue, salivary glands, liver, gall bladder, and pancreas.
