The District Court applied the test for dismissal set out in United States ex rel. Lujan v. Hughes Aircraft Co., 67 F. 3d 242, 245-247. Balancing three factors--actual harm to the Government, severity of the violations, and evidence of bad faith--the court decided against dismissal. Petitioner did not request a lesser sanction.
