iOS 14: How to adjust iPhone camera exposure and focus ...

In auto mode, the iPhone camera normally picks a low ISO and a higher shutter speed combination. You have to switch to 'manual exposure' mode to get access to controlling the shutter speed and/or the ISO. ISO ISO refers to the overall sensitivity of the sensor to light. On the iPhone 6 camera, the ISO range is from ISO 32 (low) to ISO 1600 (high).

3.1 Adjust Exposure Manually In the built-in Camera app, start by tapping to set focus. Then simply swipe up or down to adjust exposure (brightness). Swipe up to make the image brighter, or down to make it darker.

You don't get quite the depth of control over the exposure settings as you do with Manual, but you get huge control over how the footage is processed and encoded. With FiLMiC Pro you can set focus and exposure independently using the two reticules. The one resembling an aperture ring is exposure, the square one is focus. Tapping the corresponding button in the bottom left corner locks focus or exposure.

Your iPhone doesn't give you full manual control over every possible setting. In particular, the aperture and focal length of the lens are fixed to f/1.8, as well as to a full frame equivalent of 26mm (for the wide angle lens) and 51mm (for the telephoto lens).

Manual exposure is what is achieved when a photographer uses a camera in manual mode. Manual mode requires the photographer to make all the decisions that determine an image's exposure, as opposed to an automatic or semi-automatic mode that makes at least some of the calls for the photography.
