## **Guidelines on the criteria for promotion and tenure ...**

For students initially referred to special education and students who transfer into NYC DOE schools with an existing IEP, modified promotion criteria must be developed by May 20 in order to be applied for the current school year's promotion decisions. After January 31, promotion criteria can be determined for the next school year.

The criteria for promotion and tenure are based on a point scoring system that combines the three dimensions into one overall score =  $0.4 \times T + 0.3 \times R + 0.3 \times S$  where T stands for the total score on teaching, R is the total score on research and S is the total

The student's percentage of grade specific CCLS indicates the student's modified promotion criteria (e.g., the student's modified promotion criteria indicates that he or she must achieve 60% of the total CCLS comprising the grade 6 ELA standards).

## **Promotion Criteria Guidelines for Students with ...**

Promotion decisions are made by each school principal based on multiple

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measures of student readiness for the next grade level in English and math. Teachers review student work from the school year to identify students who may not be ready for the work of the next grade in English language arts and/or math, even with support.

## **2019 DepEd Guidelines on the Selection, Promotion and ...**

The unit-level criteria for promotion and tenure must meet the criteria set at the campus and university level, but the unit is free to clarify and expand the expectations at the unit level. For any given candidate, the only criteria and guidelines that apply for promotion and tenure are those set by the university, campus, and his or her own unit.

In most cases, the basis of promotion for social studies and science should be the same as the basis of promotion for language arts.
