Coding Guidelines for Wound Care. Debridement of a wound, performed before the application of topical or local anesthesia is billed with CPT codes 11042 - 11047. Wound debridements (11042-11047) are reported by the depth of tissue that is removed and by the surface area of the wound.

The ICD-10-CM is based on the ICD -10, the statistical classification of disease published by the World Health Organization (WHO).
